We are currently looking to recruit a full-time Theatre Technician (40hrs) to assist in the smooth running of all technical aspects of the venue. The successful candidate will ideally have a specialism in lighting, but be multi-skilled across

Working closely with the Technical and Buildings Manager, the Theatre Technician will assist and support incoming shows in the main house, run cinema screenings and assist with day-to-day running of the department and its equipment. The successful candidate will also be required to occasionally support the setup of the venue's other facilities including our meeting and rehearsal spaces.
